As I have visited classes over the past week it has been great to see the high levels of engagement, enthusiasm and collaboration among the students. I have particularly enjoyed seeing students showing pride in their learning and eagerly sharing this with you via our Seesaw app. I'm sure the children would love it if you were able to voice comment back to them to encourage further learning.
