



# ANIMAL SECTIONS

## CALF CLUB DAY 2020

Our annual Calf Club/Gala Day will be held on Friday 25 September this year. Drury School Calf Club is a long standing tradition and the exhibiting of calves, lambs, goats, piglets (n/a in 2020) and chickens is a great way of participating and keeping the tradition going. **For those new to Calf Club we have sheets available from the school office which offer additional information on raising these animals and a checklist of what you will need and what is required on the day.** This information may help assist with your decision on what animal will be best suited for your child.

In addition to the farm animals there is also a section for DOGS and a GENERAL PET SECTION (cats, fish, birds, rats, most unusual pet etc.)

**If your child would like to enter an animal for Calf Club Day, they will need to complete an entry form. These forms are available from the school office and are also available on the Calf Club section of the school website ([www.drury.school.nz](http://www.drury.school.nz)). Entries close on Friday 11 September and are required for the following animals:**

<b>LAMBS</b>	Must be born after 1 May	Children are expected to feed and train the lamb themselves. They are judged on (1) Leading, (2) Calling and (3) Export
<b>GOATS (KID)</b>	Must be born after 1 May	Children are expected to feed and train the goat themselves. They are judged on (1) Leading, (2) Calling and (3) Export
<b>CALVES</b>	Must be born after 1 June	Children are expected to feed and train their calf. They are judged in two sections - beef or dairy type. Calves are also led around a course. Bull calves must be 'steered'. All calves are required to be TB ear tagged and have TB forms completed before leaving your property. Calves should be brushed often but not clipped or shaved.
<b>CHICKENS</b>	Day old chicks for this section were pre-ordered and arrive on 24 July	Judging on the day will include child/chicken relationship, rearing, "My Chicken & Me" photo plus points for Crate Decorating
<b>DOGS</b>	Group One Group Two Group Three Group Four	- All puppies under 1 year regardless of age of handler - Junior, Intermediate or Senior (according to age of child) All dogs entered require to have a current vaccination and be registered. They will be required to weave in and out of 4 cones, jump over a log and obey simple commands i.e. sit, come etc.
<b>GENERAL PET</b>	i.e. cats, fish, birds, rats	Prize also awarded for "Most Unusual Pet"
<b>'MY ANIMAL &amp; ME' PHOTO COMPETITION</b>		Take a photo of your child with their calf club animal showing the special relationship and bond they have. Entries to the office by Tuesday 22 September.
