Please help us take action to stop the hunger pandemic.

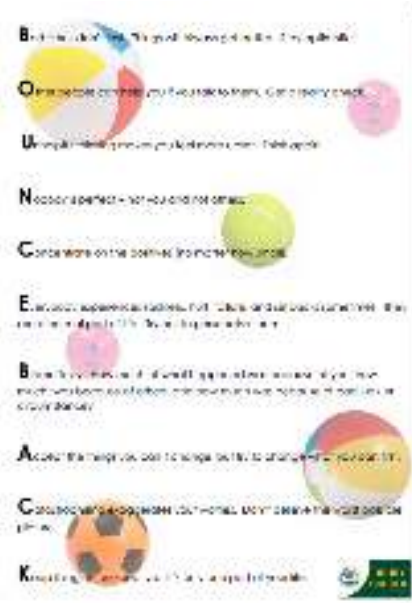


## BOUNCE BACK UPDATE

This term we have started to teach the Bounce Back lessons. Bounce Back teaches children the skills and attitudes to help them be in a positive mood most of the time, get along well with others and become more resilient.

If you are resilient you are able to cope reasonably well with difficult situations and things that go wrong and then 'bounce back'. Throughout life, children (and adults) will need skills and attitudes to help them to bounce back. They will encounter everyday challenges such as making mistakes, falling out with a friend, moving house or school and losing in a sports competition. Some will also face challenges such as adapting to a family break up, a step family, the illness or death of a family member, or being bullied.
